## Q4: Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant

MacArthur Park is once again a welcoming destination for recreation, relaxation and entertainment for the thousands of Westlake residents who consider MacArthur Park their backyard. The free concerts at Levitt Pavilion will feature culturally and musically diverse entertainment of the highest artistic caliber, free of charge to the residents of the Westlake community and the numerous surrounding neighborhoods.

In addition to the live music on stage, every concert includes activities for the entire family – with an dedicated art zone for kids and resources shared by Community Partners. These activities help sustain positive change in MacArthur Park by providing family-friendly programming.

## Q5: How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large.

Levitt Foundation and Levitt Pavilion Los Angeles believe in the power of performing arts to strengthen the community and enrich lives. Following are ways the summer concerts benefit the MacArthur Park neighborhood and surrounding communities:

- Exposure to the arts and culture for youth: As the arts are no longer present in many public schools, the summer concerts provide exposure to the arts to the thousands of children and youth in the Westlake community who do not have access to arts in their schools.
- Strengthening the community through shared experiences: Many families and individuals
  that frequent the concerts throughout the summer become friends with other concert goers from
  the community. A stronger community is developed as concert attendees laugh, dance side by
  side and share the experience together.
- Free activities for the entire family: 35% of the population of the Westlake District lives at or below poverty level. The free concerts presented by Levitt LA offer families the opportunity to enjoy high quality activities that are available in other communities throughout Los Angeles, but are cost prohibitive to most Westlake residents.
- Informing Westlake residents of community resources: At each concert, a local organization
  is featured as a Community Partner. Community Partners share information about social service
  programs, arts programs, education services, scholarship opportunities among other local
  resources and opportunities.
- Reducing crime: By providing positive programming in MacArthur Park, the number of crimes
  in the park decreases. The amount of graffiti in the northwest area decreases during the summer
  concert season as there are people in the park at night, limiting opportunities, for taggers to
  deface community property. The summer concerts at Levitt Pavilion greatly contribute to the
  positive change seen in MacArthur Park In recent years, recapturing the vibrant energy of the
  park from decades past.
