Organizational Background: MacArthur Park is a local park and recreation facility with rich history dating back to the late nineteenth century. The park is divided in two by Wilshire Boulevard. The southern portion primarily consists of a lake, while the northern half includes a small amphitheater, bandshell, synthetic sports meadow, and children's' playgrounds. The bandshell has been recently renovated as the Levitt Pavilion and is once again, and since the re-opening, the Levitt Pavilion hosts 50 free concerts each summer.

Our mission is to enrich the lives of residents of Westlake and MacArthur Park by providing a safe, welcoming park and community center. Our vision is to provide affordable recreational, physical and cultural opportunities for all of our residents.

Overview: MacArthur Park along with Council District 1 and other community partners will offer a Winter Wonderland Festival at MacArthur Park on Saturday, December 16, 2017. The festival will include a community parade, an official tree-lighting ceremony, music entertainment, holiday performances, ice-skating, toy give-away and food; all at no cost to attendees. This seasonal festival will represent a true sense of community and will allow all participants to collectively experience the spirit of the holidays and a winter wonderland in their own neighborhood.
